Waste Management

The Institute practices three R's (Reduce, Recycle and Reuse) to tackle the waste. Some initiatives are as follows.

1. Green dust bins are used for bio-degradable (wet-waste). Blue dust bins are used for Non-bio-degradable (dry-waste).
2. The wet waste is used in preparation of Manure & used as fertilizer for plants.
3. Yellow dust bins are used for Pharmaceutical waste in all Pharmacy Labs. Red dustbins are used for Biomedical waste in anatomy & pharmacology labs for proper disposal of contents to avoid contamination.
4. Liquid solvents used in laboratory for extraction process in experiments are Recovered by using Rota Evaporator & Reused again without wasting the solvent.
5. Hazardous chemicals are properly handled under the supervision of experienced faculty by taking proper necessary precautions & safeguard the students from explosions.
6. Use of Fuming chambers in Chemistry Labs are helpful in careful handling of hazardous substances.
7. Chemicals after use are properly drained into sinks with proper treatment into sewage.
8. Utilizing half used paper for rough work.
9. Canteen waste is used in bio-gas production.
10. The waste from vegetables and food are composted in a Bio-Composters and used as fertilizer for plants.
11. Encouraged to use electronic form of content instead of paper.
12. Use of Knimbus Software for E- Library resources.
